



## Public library of Bruneck / Brunico

### Computer usage and internet regulation

#### Service description

The public library of Brunico is provided with computer spots in order to use internet or to work with other functions (e.g. elaboration of texts). The spots can be used by visitors during the opening time and the usage is free.

The users can use a USB memory unit, external drives or CD units. A printer is also available.

It is not possible to download data and programmes from the internet.

The public library staff, thanks to its technical capacities, is ready to help the users with eventual suggestions, if the service allows it.

In order to use these work spots, the following regulations must be followed:

- The users under the age of 14 years have to bring a consent declaration signed by their parents or they must be accompanied by an adult.
- Internet cannot be used for purposes which are currently forbidden by the law. This regards websites that have:
  - pornographic content
  - national-socialist, fascist and/or anti-semitic content
  - violence content.

#### Regulations

The users have full responsibility for the visited websites.

If the regulation is not respected, the connection will be instantly interrupted. The user will automatically lose the internet usage right in the public library and he is reported to the qualified authorities.

- The users are responsible for all the damages they have caused to the machines and/or to the programmes and they have to compensate for them.
- The usage of other software links is not allowed
- The user has to protect his personal data.
- The prices for printing documents are:
  - black and white: 0,10 Euro per page
  - colorized: 0,30 Euro per page

The library is not responsible for the connection and the information type and quality.

The connection data is registered and analysed from the qualified authorities, following the indications of the law.
